This funding will be used to

- Increase the Mean Scale Score (MSS) in Year 3 NAPLAN Writing and Reading by an average of 30 points by May 2020.
- Increase the Mean Scale Score (MSS) in Year 5 NAPLAN Reading from 500.3 to 515 point by May 2020.
- Increase inter-school moderation opportunities to twice per year to monitor and review our A-E data in the English and Mathematics curriculum areas.

Our initiatives include

- Developing the teacher knowledge and understandings of the P-10 Australian Curriculum achievement standards and content descriptors for English and Mathematics.
- Developing teachers' capability to embed intra-school and inter-school moderation processes to support effective teacher judgement and feedback to students.
- Regularly monitoring student writing samples through the use of an Individual Writing Folio that is used to set future goals, monitor goals and provide feedback to all students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing an additional teacher aide to increase the opportunities for the monitoring of Writing and Reading goals, targeted differentiation and feedback for all students.	\$30,000
Employing additional teachers (as needed) to enable inter-school moderation between our cluster of schools focusing on our calibration of our A-E achievement of our English and Mathematics.	\$ 2,235
