This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A-C in English in Years 1-2 from 76.2% (2016) to 85% (2017).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an A-C in English in Years 5-6 from 75% (2016) to 85% (2017).
- Increase the MSS in NAPLAN writing in Year 3 from being below the national cohort to being similar (or above) the Queensland cohort.

Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum achievement standards and content descriptors by designing and implementing supportive intra-school and inter-school moderation processes.
- Developing a shared understanding of 'data-literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching in the early years of education.
- Developing a plan for monitoring early phase literacy and numeracy, including the scheduling of Early Start Assessments and opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress.
- Developing and implementing peer coaching and feedback cycles by building the capacity of staff to give and receive feedback using Collegial Coaching or Classroom Profiling.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing an additional teacher aide to increase the opportunities for targeted differentiation and feedback for all students (\$25000).
- Providing professional development and ongoing opportunities for collegial coaching and/or Classroom Profiling (\$5000).
- Providing TRS in order to embed Early Start diagnostic materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform future teaching, learning and resourcing (\$2000).
- Providing TRS in order to facilitate inter-school moderation of student work samples (\$1355).
