Under this agreement for 2022 Nebo State School will receive

\$36,626*

This funding will be used to

Implement an intervention program focussed on:

- identifying students requiring additional support (including students with and without a diagnosed disability) or extension (including students identified as Gifted and Talented);
- developing individualised plans focussed on at what level the students are currently performing, and the next steps of learning;
- providing intensive one-on-one or small group intervention with a trained staff member;
- increasing communication with parents/care givers in regards to the child's progress.

Our initiatives include

A tiered approach to differentiated teaching ensuring that students who require support beyond good first quality teaching are prioritised.

- For each student receiving intervention, a five-week cycle of inquiry will take place. Short term goals will be identified and worked towards. This cycle will ensure that student learning is monitored throughout the five weeks, and thus adjustments can be made to maximise learning.

Where possible, intervention will take place within the classroom with peers. This will ensure inclusion remains at the forefront of the work taking place.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing a teacher aide to administer the intervention lessons across the week. Employment will be in in Term 1 and conclude in Term 4.	\$33,026
Providing professional development for teacher aide and purchase resources to support implementation of reading program.	\$3,600

Key Data Sets:

- Decrease in the number of students on an Individual Curriculum Plan (2020 — 5 students)
- Continuation of no student disciplinary absences (suspensions)
- Increase in the number of parents agreeing that their child is making good progress (School Opinion Survey - 2019 - 90%)
- Increase in the number of students attaining a 'C' or above in English 2020 — 93.8%)
