

Nebo State School

2024-2026 Uniform Policy



In accordance with section 360 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (Qld), Nebo State School has developed this student dress code that applies when students are attending, or representing, the school. The dress code:

- was developed in consultation with the school community (parents, staff and students)
- is consistent with health and safety considerations (sun safety, visibility, heat and other risk management practices)
- complies with anti-discrimination legislation (including religious, cultural, socio-economic and gender considerations)
- consider affordability, functionality and durability of uniform items (minimise the need for school specific clothing)

This policy, through agreement with the Parent and Citizen Association (P&C) will be in enforced until the end of 2026.

COMPULSORY: All long hair (shoulder length or longer) tied up or back.

OPTIONAL: A single pair of earrings (studs or sleepers) only. Sunglasses may be worn while outside.

OPTIONAL: Plain dark or bottle green jumper or jacket on cold days (no other colours accepted). The P&C have branded jackets available for purchase.

COMPULSORY: No rings, bracelets or nail polish permitted on hands at any time.

COMPULSORY: All students wear plain dark or bottle green shorts, skirts, skorts or pants every school day.




COMPULSORY: Sunsafe (broad brimmed) hat, dark green preferred. Dark green hats required for school excursions for visibility reasons. The P&C have reversible hats available for purchase.

OPTIONAL: Religious or culturally significant necklace permitted under shirt. Necklace must remain on at all times (except during swimming).

COMPULSORY: Nebo State School uniform shirt to be worn on every school day by all students (except for Kindergarten students and Year 6 students wearing senior shirts). Plain red shirts accepted.

COMPULSORY: No make-up or face colouring permitted (except during school and Brigalow sporting events)



OPTIONAL: Students in Year 6 elected as school leaders are able to wear their leaders badge on any school day.

OPTIONAL: Students in Year 6 are able to wear designated senior shirts on school days with no special events.

OPTIONAL: All students are able to wear one watch or fitness tracker (on wrist). These should remain on the wrist at all times.

COMPULSORY: All students are required to wear closed in shoes. <u>Black shoes and socks are not required</u>. Boots are not acceptable.



COMPULSORY: For visibility reasons, kindergarten students are required to wear plain orange polo shirts every school day, including at school events. Black or green coloured bottoms. If wanting to wear a jumper, this must be orange as well.

On days where the Nebo State School Uniform policy is temporarily suspended, such as Free Dress days, families will be given prior warning, however all clothing must meet safety requirements (including sun safe and closed in shoes). Nebo State School, in collaboration with the P&C, will implement strategies designed to inform families of the expectations of the uniform policy and provide support to ensure all student are able to comply.
